7th Grade Pre-Algebra Students Win Big at ACSI Math League Competition

Seventh grade Pre-Algebra students in Miss Stanley and Mrs. Fairley's class competed against hundreds of students in Georgia, North Carolina, Alabama, and other states in the ACSI Math League Competition. Math League is a competition open to students in middle and high school that are currently enrolled in Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, and Calculus. Students take a series of four tests during their math classes and their tests are sent in to ACSI headquarters to compete against the tests of other students from other schools.

Students were amazed to see speakers mention concepts such as slope, ratio, metrics, equations, and many other topics that they study in their math classes each day. A huge thank you to all the speakers their time.

May Math Club Events -

The **May 9th & 10th Math Club** began with Origametry! Origametry is a word we've invented to show how Origami and geometry go hand-in-hand. Students created various three dimensional shapes that provided valuable lessons in symmetry and reflection. They created cubes that inflated and pinwheels using eight parallelograms. This was lots of fun and the students learned a little bit of geometry in the process.

The **May 17th Math Club** meeting is the last club meeting for this school year, and will consist of a pizza party, awards presentations and math strategy game day! The awards given at this meeting will be to students who have excelled at the First In Math Online Game, such as Preston Devonshire, who is now ranked #3 in the state of Georgia on the First in Math Online 24 Game. Preston's score is also ranked 80 in the nation among hundreds of students. All Math Club students will receive certificates, participate in drawings for prizes, and play math strategy games such as Rumikube, dominoes, Equate, Sudoku, Connect 4!

The Young Chargers Enrichment Program has, at its heart, the goal to help young people become good examples in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity (1 Tim. 4:12).

YCEP will provide a service to parents by supplying safe, quality, loving, Christian-based care for our student population just completing Kindergarten through 5th grade. We will adhere to a maximum 15/1 student/teacher ratio per classroom.

Activities include art, music, reading, Bible, crafts, computer skills, sports, games, free play, field trips, pizza/ice cream parties and more!

We will be using the existing ELCA emergency contact/medical release forms on file. Please let us know if you need to update your form or need to complete a form.

Lunch and Snacks: A morning snack will be provided. Lunch and afternoon snack (if desired) need to be brought from home.

Dress Code: Comfortable, weather-appropriate attire.
Sports shoes. (If sandals are worn, please bring sports shoes.)
No sleeveless tops.
Shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee.
Students will not be allowed to remain on campus while in violation of these rules.

Discipline: In the case of a discipline problem, an Incident Report will be completed by a YCEP staff member. It will then be given to the parent upon arrival. Parent will sign the report, and it will remain in the student's file. ELCA has the right to dismiss any student who habitually exhibits unacceptable behavior, without refund of fees.

Accidents/Injuries: In the event of an accident/injury, an Accident Report will be completed by a YCEP staff member. Parent will be notified immediately of any injury other than that of a very minor nature.
