Parents & Students,

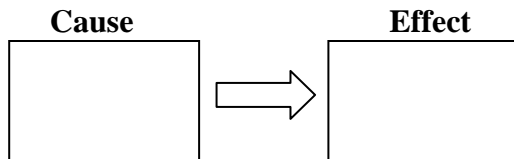
Since ELCA has an account with Barnes & Noble, we arranged for the book to be ordered and delivered to the store location on Mt. Zion Road. It will be available for purchase and pick-up by June 13<sup>th</sup>. Each student should go to Barnes & Noble to purchase their individual copy of the book.

Before reading the book, be familiar with the assignment, but please read the book before completing the assignment. I encourage students to highlight/underline any important/relevant passages in the book or any unfamiliar words/phrases in the book. This summer reading assignment is mandatory. Students should bring the book and completed assignments to class on August 1, 2011.

**Assignment 1 - Summary:** At the conclusion of each chapter, students should write a **summary** (include all of the 5W's: who, what, where, when, and why) on 4x6 note cards. Each chapter summary should be on a separate note card. Information should be written in paragraph form using complete sentences.

**Assignment 2 - Cause/Effect:** In Billy Sunday's life, many decisions and choices had an impact on his life experiences. Using flowchart boxes, illustrate five separate life experiences of Billy Sunday. The boxes should be in chronological order.

**Assignment 3 - Literature Response:** Discuss three of the five life experiences from the previous section. Explain in your own words how each experience impacted/affected God's calling on Billy's life. Your response must include at least six complete sentences.
