

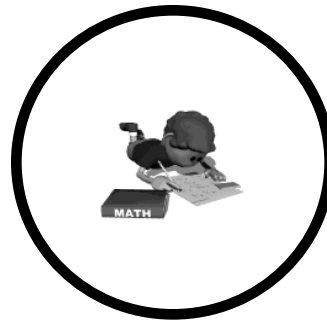
Math Club Activities
