

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (2011)

College Entrance

- 77% of graduates continued their education at a 4 year college or university
- 17% continued at a 2 year college
- 78% remained in Georgia
- 16% went out of state

College Entrance Exams

The top ten percent of the 2011 class scored an average of 2053 and the top twenty-five percent scored an average of 1893 on the SAT.

AP Exams

60% of those taking an Advanced Placement test earned a qualifying score of 3 or better on at least one exam.

AP Scholars

- Five students were named AP Scholars (received scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP exams).
- Two students were named AP Scholars with Honors (received an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams).
- Three students were named AP Scholars with Distinction (received an average score of 3.5 on all AP exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams).

Scholarship Awards

Members of the class of 2011 were offered over 3,000,000 in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.

65% were eligible for the HOPE Scholarship.
