

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2026) – 51 graduates

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2026 was accepted to 98 colleges and universities and will attend 45 different post- secondary institutions.
- 100% of graduates continued their education at a 4- year college or university.
- 74% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 22% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2026 were offered \$13.1 million in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.

SAT

- The top 10% = 1480
