ADVANCEMENT PLACEMENT

ELCA offers 23 Honors classes and 18 Advanced Placement courses. The earliest a student may take an AP class is in grade 9. Three AP classes is considered a full load; however, exceptions are allowed. Students enrolled in AP courses are required to sit for the national exam.

ATHLETICS

ELCA participates in the Georgia High School Association and has 14 varsity sports. Athletics is an integral part of the educational process that impacts the lives of many students.

ELCA has had 41 State Final Four appearances, 24 State Runner-Up appearances, 18 State Championships, and 30 Individual State Championships.

In 2018, our Varsity softball team became the 1st team in GHSA history to win 7 State Championships.

In 2019, our Varsity football team became the 1st team in GHSA history to win 5 State Championships in a row.

Varsity and JV teams include: Cross Country, Football, Softball, Spirit Cheer, Volleyball, Boys and Girls Basketball, Wrestling, Baseball, Bass Fishing, Boys and Girls Lacrosse, Boys and Girls Soccer, and Track & Field.

ARTS

The School of Fine Arts is an essential element of the overall curriculum and the educational strategy at Eagle's Landing Christian Academy. ELCA's fine arts programs are specifically designed to move students through an aligned curriculum from PreK-12th grade, that preps them to study fine arts at college. ELCA offers a robust offering of visual and performing arts disciplines.

ACADEMICS

ACADEMIC PROGRAM

The academic program is organized around a 7-period day with the school year divided into two semesters. Honors classes are offered in all academic disciplines. Students must have a teacher recommendation to enroll. In addition to the 20 Honors classes offered at ELCA, 18 Advanced Placement courses are offered including AP Seminar and AP Research.

STUDENTS

Students are admitted based on previous school record, standardized test scores, recommendations, and an interview. The school seeks to enroll students from all socio-economic and ethnic backgrounds. ELCA admits students without regard to race, color, religion, gender, or national or ethnic origin.

CLASS RANK

Eagle's Landing Christian Academy does provide a specific numerical class rank for the purpose of college admission. Beginning with 9th grade, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. The transcript reflects a weighted and unweighted cumulative overall and cumulative academic GPA (English, math, science, social studies, and foreign language). Semester grades in Honors courses are weighted .25 per semester on the GPA scale. AP/DE (dual enrollment) courses are weighted .5 on the GPA scale.

ACADEMIC STATISTICS

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2026 was accepted to 98 colleges and universities and will attend 45 different post-secondary institutions.
- 100% of graduates continued their education at a 4-year college or university.
- 74% matriculating to college remained in Georgia.
- 22% matriculating to college went out of state.

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2026 were offered \$13.1 million in grants, academic, and athletic scholarships.

NOTEWORTHY PROGRAMS

Unity Council: Students at ELCA have the privilege of growing up in a richly diverse student population. In a focused effort to strengthen the diverse culture, an established Council on Diversity meets to discuss critical issues within the school. The council consists of students, staff members, and parents.

World Impact: This extends curriculum beyond the classroom to provide students with cultural, educational, and ministerial experiences both locally and around the world.

Student Support Services/MERIT (Multi-faceted Educational Resources and Instructional Technology):

Students who are served by the MERIT Program must be identified through a multi-faceted evaluation as exhibiting a learning difference that significantly impedes their academic progress. A current (within the last three years) comprehensive evaluation of the student's cognitive, academic achievement, social, behavioral, etc. domains must be on file at the school.

Dual Enrollment: ELCA has partnered with Truett-McConnell University and Southern Crescent Technical College to offer select courses in which students can earn both high school and college credit.

The AP® School Honor Roll: ELCA has earned "gold" status in this prestigious annual recognition program that celebrates schools whose AP programs have done outstanding work. Schools earn this based on criteria that reflect a commitment to increasing college-going culture, providing opportunities for students to earn college credit, and maximizing college readiness.

ELCA Connect: If an ELCA student desires to take a class not offered within traditional ELCA curricula, they may take that class in the ELCA Connect online program if approved by the Guidance Office.

AP Capstone School: AP Capstone™ is a diploma program from the College Board. It's based on two year-long AP courses: AP Seminar and AP Research. These courses develop students' skills in research, analysis, evidence-based arguments, collaboration, writing, and presenting. Students who complete the two-year program can earn one of two different AP Capstone awards, which are valued by colleges across the United States and around the world.
