

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2025) – 87 graduates

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2025 was accepted to 102 colleges and universities and will attend 45 different post- secondary institutions.
- 92% of graduates continued their education at a 4- year college or university.
- 4% of graduates continued their education at a 2- year community or technical college.
- 4% military, other
- 74% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 22% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2025 were offered \$14.9 million in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.
