

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2023) – 81 graduates

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2023 was accepted to 142 colleges and universities and will attend 39 different post- secondary institutions.
- 89% of graduates continued their education at a 4- year college or university.
- 7% of graduates continued their education at a 2- year community or technical college.
- 4% military, other
- 54% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 44% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2023 were offered \$50.6 million in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.
