

Merit Rising 10th grade Summer Reading 2023

The Fifth Mountain by Paulo Coelho. Publisher:HarperOne ISBN: 0060930136

Students are asked to get a hard copy of this book to read this summer and annotate. Class discussion and a written assessment will take place during the first week of school.

We will be reading this book this summer and looking for observations on obedience and consequences. Specifically, we will explore a) the ways characters make choices that they know to be sinful/wrong, b) ways that characters are obedient to the will of God and c) ways that characters find God's Grace.

To prepare you for class discussion and a paper when we return to school, please complete the following steps as you read:

1. Get a copy of the book.
2. Complete the guided reading questions for each section.
3. You must type your responses and be prepared to upload the document into GoogleClassroom when the school year begins.
4. Highlight in your book where you find the answers.

12. Which nation brings troops outside of the city?
13. Who is blamed for the death of the widow's son?
14. What is the consequence?
15. When Elijah returns, what happens to the boy?

9. Why do merchants in Akbar prefer to use papyrus, even though it must be imported and is expensive?

7. What does the widow make them promise?
8. How had the boy escaped the fire?
9. Who do Elijah and the boy get food from?
10. Why are Elijah and the boy going back to Akbar?
