

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2022) – 79 graduates

Post-secondary Plans

- The class of 2022 was accepted to 140 colleges and universities and will attend 39 different post- secondary institutions.
- 91% of graduates continued their education at a 4- year college or university.
- 2% of graduates continued their education at a 2- year community or technical college.
- 7% military, other
- 69% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 31% matriculating to college went out of state

Members of the class of 2022 were offered \$8,121,103 million in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.
